Behaviour

- Each person attending MYC11 is required to demonstrate Christ-like behaviour at all times. Think about what Jesus would do before you act. Keep that in mind and we'll all have a truly awesome and uplifting time!
- We have such a spiritually uplifting week prepared that you won't need to bring worldly distractions such as iPods, radios, etc. Try doing without them for a week!
- Please select suitable and modest clothing for all activities, including swimming. Clothing should be appropriate for the activity, whether it be a study or a sports afternoon. In particular, we ask you to dress respectfully for the memorial meeting. Sisters are requested to wear a head-covering to the memorial meeting.
- No alcohol or non-prescription drugs are allowed at the camp. Please only bring things that will help us to have a spiritually beneficial week together.

In facilitating the gathering of such a large number of young people with different needs we ask that you are mindful and respectful of the needs of others as Christ would have us to be.
